Brig O'Johnston bridge at Clarence Town closed after vehicle collision

Motorists are advised the Brig O'Johnston Bridge on Limeburners Creek Road at Clarence Town remains closed to all traffic after the bridge was damaged by a heavy vehicle on Wednesday 12 July.

Transport for NSW bridge engineers initially assessed the damage on Thursday 13 July, with further inspections needed in coming weeks to identify necessary repairs to ensure the bridge can be reopened safely to motorists.

The ongoing inspections involve installing scaffold to inspect under the bridge.

Road users are advised the bridge remains unsafe for all vehicles until repairs to the damaged bridge supports are carried out, with a timeframe for this still to be determined.

Detour routes for all vehicles will be in place while repairs are completed.

A detour for light vehicles is available to the north via Glen William, Pine Bush and Glen Martin roads; or to the south via Duke Street, Clarence Town and East Seaham roads; both are expected to add up to 30 minutes travel time.

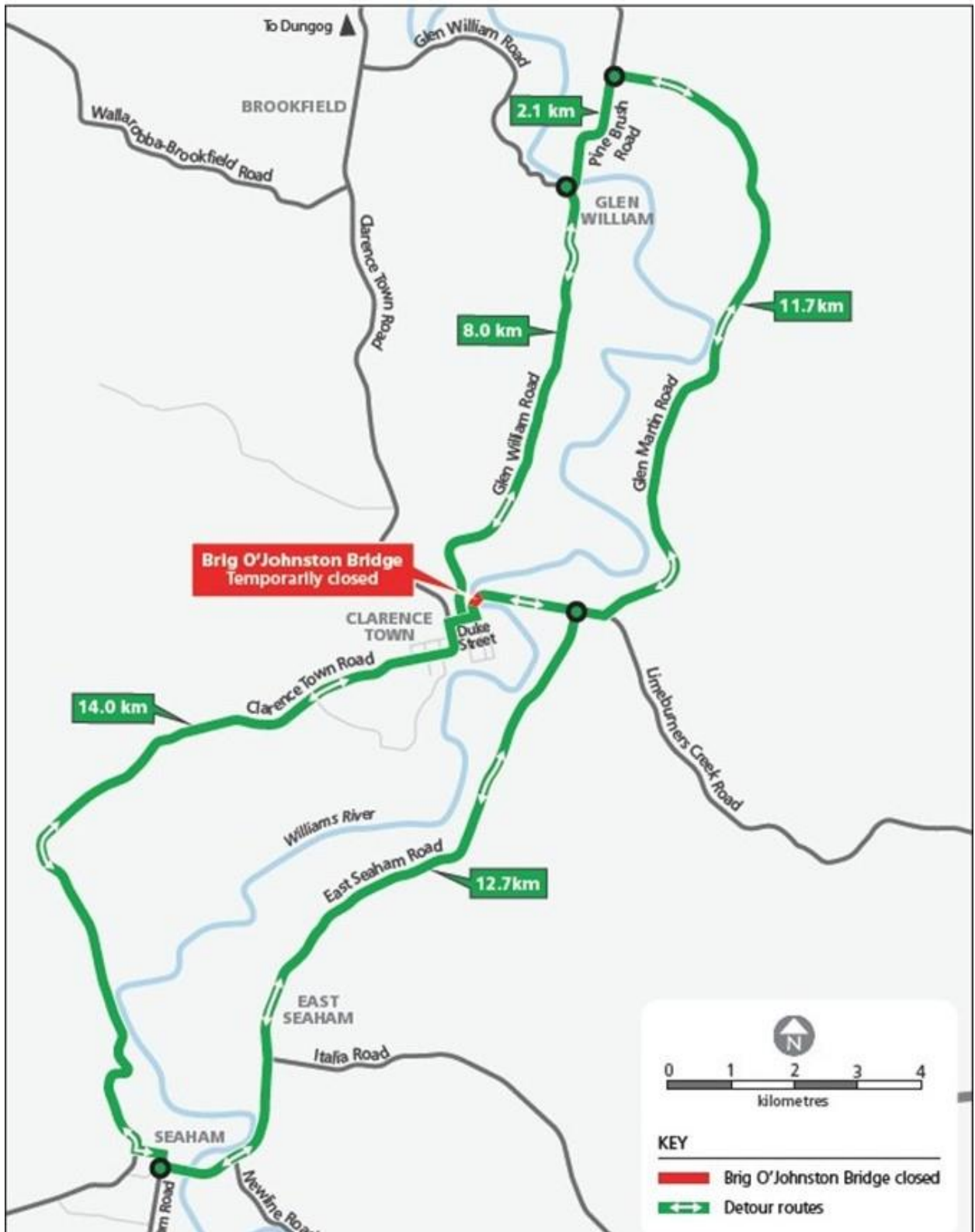
A detour for heavy vehicles is available via Clarence Town, East Seaham and Italia roads, the Pacific Highway and The Bucketts Way, which is expected to add up to 50 minutes travel time.

Heavy and light vehicle drivers should plan their journey and allow extra travel time, drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
